

GENERAL PRIVACY POLICY

By entering into contact with us, regardless the manner in which we communicate (e-mail, telephone, letter, etc.), you provide us certain personal data and you consent that we, DP World Antwerp Holding NV, with registered address at 9130 Beveren, Molenweg (KAL), Haven 1950 and number in the CBE 0406.070.605., shall process these personal data in the context of our collaboration. It is also possible that we collected your personal data through other channels, e.g. because they were published online on your (employer's) website, via one of your colleagues or business partners.

In most circumstances it shall primarily concern contact details, such as your full name, e-mail address, telephone number, profession (function), we need to answer your request or to be able to work together with you.

The processing of personal data is (most likely) based on article 5.a. (consent), 5.b. (necessary for the performance of a contract or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract) or 5.f. (legitimate interests – processing with a view of a smooth and efficient day-to-day carrying out of our activities) and could, depending on our relation, be based on any other ground in article 5 of the Act of 8 December 1992 on the protection of privacy in relation to the processing of personal data and article 6.a. (consent), 6.a. 6.b. (necessary for the performance of a contract or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract) and 6.f. (legitimate interests – processing with a view of a smooth and efficient day-to-day carrying out of our activities) and could, depending on our relation, be based on any other ground in article 6 of the General Data Protection Regulation (Reg.2016/679).

Depending on our relationship your personal data might be processed for different purposes, nevertheless this will most likely constitute administration, the performance of an agreement between us and you (or your employer), our collaboration or providing answers to your requests (or the other way around). If you consented thereto, we will also use your personal data to send commercial communications (direct marketing).

Your personal data may be shared with other companies within the DP World group. To the extent necessary in the context of our (contractual) relationship, we can also share your personal data with some of our partners. We guarantee that these receivers shall undertake to process your personal data in compliance with the applicable legislation. If your personal data is processed outside the European Economic Area we will use our best efforts to conclude the necessary (contractual) safeguards in this regard (e.g. EC Standard Clauses or similar contractual safeguards).
