

PRIVACY POLICY REGARDING TRUCK DRIVERS

By entering the business premises of DPW Antwerp you consent that amongst others DP World Antwerp Holding NV, with registered address at 9130 Beveren, Molenweg (KAL), Haven 1950, subscribed in the Crossroads bank for Enterprises under number 0406.070.605. shall process your personal data in the context of the activities you will perform on DPW Antwerp's premises. We collect these personal data both directly from you or through other channels (e.g. Alfapass). This concerns amongst others your first and last name, address, date of birth, picture, telephone number and license plate.

The processing of personal data is based upon article 5 c) (necessity for compliance with a legal obligation) and f) (legitimate interest) of the Act of 8 December 1992 on the protection of privacy in relation to the processing of personal data and article 6.1.c) (necessity for compliance with a legal obligation) and f) (legitimate interest) of the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation 2016/679).

The personal data are processed for administrative purposes, to provide you access to the business premises (e.g. access control in the context of the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS) and European Regulation n°725/2004) and for reasons of general safety (e.g. speed limit controls) and security. To the extent necessary to carry-out these purposes your personal data shall be shared with other companies within the DP World group as well as other recipients outside the group (e.g. AWS, Navis, Alfapass, security company, etc.). We ensure that these DP World companies as well as the other recipients undertake to process your personal data in accordance with applicable legislation. In the event these recipients will process your personal data outside the European Economic Area, we shall use our best efforts to establish the necessary (contractual) safeguards as required by data protection law (e.g. EC Standard Clauses or conclude similar contractual safeguards).

When legally justified or required, the personal data may also be transferred to competent governments and/or other law enforcement authorities (e.g. police, investigating judge, national data protection authority, etc.).

You are entitled to access your personal data and have them rectified when inaccurate or incomplete, to have them erased and to object the processing thereof or have the processing thereof restricted when the legal conditions thereto are met. You are entitled to obtain a copy of your personal data (in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format) and to have your personal data transferred to another controller (right to data portability).

The personal data shall be retained as long as required by law.
